

RULES
SIBLEY COUNTY REPUBLICANS CONVENTION
February 05, 2021

1. Robert's Rules of Order, Revised, shall be the parliamentary authority on all points not covered by the Constitution of the Republican Party of Minnesota, the statutes of the State of Minnesota, the Official call of this Convention, or the rules adopted by this Convention.
2. The permanent roll of this Convention shall be constituted as follows: The duly elected delegates of each precinct, elected at the February precinct caucuses to the Sibley County Convention. If any duly elected delegate to this convention is absent, then a duly elected alternate from that precinct shall be seated in his / her stead. The order of seating of alternates shall be as follows:
 - a. If the alternate vote count from the precinct caucus is available, then alternates will be seated in order of vote given.
 - b. If this information is unavailable, then alternates shall be elected by majority vote of seated delegates of that precinct.
 - c. If no duly elected delegates or alternates are present, then there shall be no representation from that precinct.
 - d. If a delegate is replaced by an alternate, then the delegate shall be seated immediately when said delegate returns to the convention floor.
3. A quorum shall be declared after the preliminary reports of the Credentials Committee and shall not be questioned again during the course of the Convention.
4. Only persons whose names are entitled to be entered upon the permanent roll of this Convention shall be permitted to vote or to address the convention.
5. A delegate wishing to speak shall raise their hand in ZOOM, wait to be recognized, address the chair, state his name, precinct, and the purpose for which he rises. Debate upon any motion or subject shall be limited to one minute by each speaker. No person shall be allowed to speak more than twice upon the same question. The parliamentarian shall be the official timekeeper.
6. Resolutions debate shall be limited to three for and three against.
7. The vote on all questions shall be by electronic vote
8. Resolutions may be presented from the floor of the Convention upon a simple majority of said Convention. The resolutions must be given to the Convention chair in written form.
9. These rules shall not be amended or suspended except by a two-thirds vote of the convention.
10. Guest speaking times
 - a. Elected Officials: 5 minutes to speak followed by a 15-minute Question/Answer session
 - b. Candidates: 3 minutes to speak
 - c. Special Guest: 20 minutes to present followed by a 10 minute Question/Answer session

**ELECTION PROCEDURES

In accordance with the Constitution of the Sibley County Republican Party, this Convention is authorized to select the following:

1. Executive Committee (10 members)

| Treasurer | 1 |

2. State Central Committee Delegate and Alternates (4 positions)

| Position Description | Number of Positions |
|--------------------------------------|----------------------------|
| State Central Committee Delegate | Reserved for Chairperson |
| State Central Committee Alternate #1 | 1 |
| State Central Committee Alternate #2 | 1 |
| State Central Committee Alternate #3 | 1 |

3. Nominations for offices and Alternates will be recommended by the Nominations Committee. There shall be no nominations from the floor.
4. The Convention Chair shall appoint tellers for each election who shall not be candidates on that ballot.
5. For a ballot to be considered valid, the number of votes cast on each ballot must be equal to the number of positions to fill. A vote of acclamation may be considered for uncontested elections.

| At-Large Member | 5 | 5 |
| State Central Committee Alternate | 3 | 3 |

6. In the event of a tie vote, a second ballot shall be cast (only considering the tied candidates) for the purpose of breaking the tie. If the vote remains tied after the second ballot, then that tie shall be broken by the drawing of lots.

7. State Central Committee alternates will be ranked in the order of votes received.
